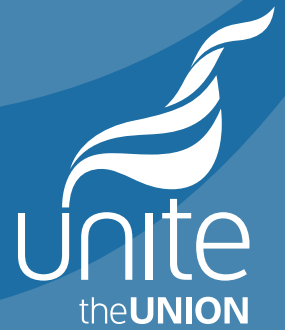


Defend Social Care and Housing
